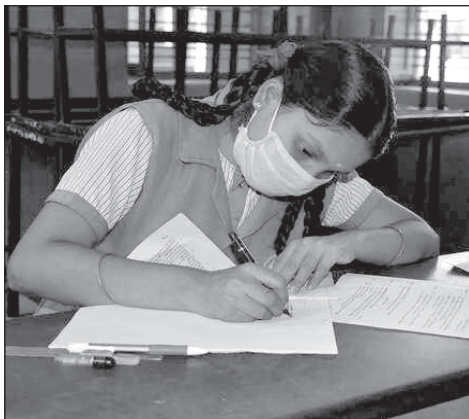

Students demand cancellation of CBSE Board's 10th and 12th examinations

The students have demanded cancellation of CBSE board's 10th and 12th standard examinations through an online petition.

The hash tags #cancelboardexam2021, #CancelourCBSEboardexam2021 and #CancelBoards2021 are also trending on Twitter. The CBSE board, however, is adamant on its decision to conduct the exams. Both the CBSE and the ICSE (Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination CISCE) have made it clear that full health precautions have been taken. The boards have also clarified that all the guidelines of Kovid-19 will be strictly followed during the examinations. However, the students said in a petition on Change.org that,

"The situation in India is getting worse by the day. Board exams were cancelled when the number of coroners in the country was low and now schools are being reopened when the transition is at its peak. We urge the Minister of Education to consider the matter and cancel all examinations taking place this year. Because students are already under a lot of stress.

This year, board exams are starting late due to corona infection. Under normal circumstances, the board's practical exams start in January and the written exams start in February and end in March, but due to the epidemic, the exams will be held in May-June this year.

MPSC Exam 2021 Postponed

The Maharashtra State Public Service Commission (MPSC) has decided to postpone the pre-service examination to be held on Sunday, April 11. The new date will be announced soon by the commission. Maharashtra Secondary Service Non-Gazetted Group-B Joint Pre-Examination was to be held next Sunday. It has been suspended immediately. The decision has been announced by the Chief Minister in an urgent meeting.

42,700 candidates have registered for this exam. Examinations were to be held at 109 sub-centers in Maharashtra. The administration had also made preparations in this regard, but the state of corona infection in the state was deteriorating day by day. It also put a strain on the government system. Therefore, there was a demand to postpone the examination. In a meeting convened by Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray, it was



decided to postpone the examination. The Chief Minister said that the dates of the exams would be announced anew through MPSC, taking into account the situation in the state. He further said that the decision has been taken unanimously considering the safety of the students and the views and demands of the students and various political parties in this regard as the number of corona patients is increasing rapidly in the state. It was clarified in the meeting that the postponement of the examination will not be to the detriment of the students and also the age of the students will be taken into consideration while filling up the examination forms.

How will common entrance exam for admission to undergraduate courses help EWS students

The education ministry is mulling over the decision to conduct a common entrance test for admission in undergraduate (UG) courses across all 54 central universities. A seven-member committee headed by RP Tiwari, VC of Central University of Punjab, will submit its report within a month and the move may get implemented for 2021-22.

"There is a lack of uniformity in the UG admission process as some universities conduct entrance test while few rely on merit-based admissions. This will simplify the admission process while customising the exam pattern."

"Students diversity is poor across universities; the central admission process may allow students from all walks of life to enrol in desired varsities and courses," Tiwari says.

The committee is expected to meet on January 9, 2021, to finalise the report before submitting it. Given the academic disruption caused by the coronavirus pandemic, there is uncertainty regarding the schedule of various entrance exams and many states have also rescheduled the board exams for May-June 2021.

Rama Shanker Dubey, vice chancellor of the Central University of Gujarat, says, "Some of the most sought-after universities conduct their entrance tests and it becomes difficult for students from economically weaker sections (EWS) to keep a tab, apply and appear for all the exams. Appearing for different exams also means that one has to pay the application fee for multiple tests.



Common entrance test may also help in getting the academic cycle back on track in lesser time," Dubey says.

"We have multiple state boards across the country and relative marking with respect to these boards can be a problem. But, the move also has a positive side where students will get through the UG admissions in just one test. The ministry will have to consider diverse factors before implementing it," says Rajib Ray, professor, Kirori Mal College, Delhi University and president of Delhi University Teachers' Association (DUTA).

RK Kohli, senior academician and former VC of Central University of Punjab, says that conducting a common exam is always a good idea as it has been in practice for postgraduate (PG) admissions for several years, but it can also cause a divide between the old and new universities. "In central admission processes, students' first preference is always to join an old, well-known and reputed university. While most new universities are not so popular, they are performing well as per assessment parameters. The uniform process may not allow all universities, new or old, to compete on the same level. Universities in the rural belt may be at a disadvantage and those in metropolitan regions will definitely receive more applications," Kohli says.

NEET 2021 scores may be used for admission to B.Sc. Nursing, Life Sciences

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has announced that the result of National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) 2021 can be used for admission to undergraduate Nursing and Life Sciences programmes.

The NEET scores were till now used for admission to MBBS, BDS, AYUSH and Veterinary programmes under the all India quota and state quota.



The Medical Council Committee (MCC) uses NEET result for admission to MBBS and BDS, AYUSH. The scores will now also be used for counselling or admission to relevant courses by Indian Nursing Council, Nursing Colleges and Schools, JIPMER NEET 2021 is scheduled to be held on August 1 in 11 languages. Sanskrit needs contemporary curriculum to attract young generation

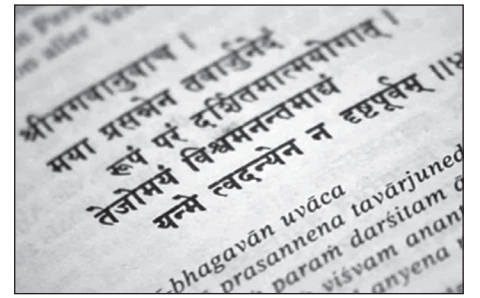

To attract young generation and boost the employability of those learning Sanskrit, it has become essential to revamp the curriculum by including new-age contents and skill-based components.

"To stay competitive and relevant in the market one needs to be skilled in their respective areas. It is important to change the perception of Sanskrit as a language for religious matters," says Parameswar Narayan Shastri, vice-chancellor, Central Sanskrit University, Delhi.

"Modification is needed in the curriculum to make students job-ready. Studying Sanskrit makes you familiar with the traditional Indian language, but it is equally important to gain skills relevant in today's time. A multidisciplinary approach by integrating new-age subjects taught and learnt in Sanskrit is a must," explains Shastri. The new generation needs to learn the language in a simpler form, for which bi-lingual publications should also be encouraged, he adds.

"The inclusion of new-age technology-related courses will make Sanskrit students employable in IT sectors. Few universities including Karnataka Sanskrit University, BHU, JNU and DU etc are offering Computational Linguistics courses in Sanskrit. For the last four to five years, after passing out, the students get jobs in prominent IT companies



including Google, Amazon, Microsoft, Samsung, CDAC, NIC and many other IT companies," says Ranjan Kumar Tripathi, professor, Department of Sanskrit, University of Delhi (DU). He adds that universities need to include the Ayurveda, Computational Linguistics, Yoga, Science and Technology, Management courses in Sanskrit syllabus.

Ways to popularise the subject

To popularise Sanskrit among the young generation, the language needs to be glamourised. Siddhidatri Bhardwaj, assistant professor, Department of Sanskrit, Banaras Hindu University (BHU) says this can be done only by making it entertaining. "It is the responsibility of teachers and media to popularise the subject among the young generation and change their perception about Sanskrit," says Bhardwaj.

"We need to have dedicated shows, conference and seminars to generate curiosity and interest for the subject that is considered a religious language," says Bhardwaj.

The results of JEE Main February 2021 session was released by the National Testing Agency on Monday, March 8. The results have been declared within 10 days since the completion of the engineering entrance examination. The exam was conducted between February 23 and February 26 in multiple shifts for around 6.6 lakh students. Six students have secured 100 percentile marks. Out of them, two are Delhi boys as per the data shared by NTA.

Pravar Kataria and Rajim Prabal Das of Delhi have scored



100 percentile with 296 and 291 marks out of 300 respectively. The other four students who scored 100 percentile marks are Saket Jha from Rajasthan, Guramrit Singh from Chandigarh, Siddhant Mukherjee from Maharashtra, and Ananth Krishna Kidambi from Gujarat.
